

ELEVATOR NEWS

The month of November 2022 ended with significant progress on the St. Cecilia Elevator Project.



11/17/2022 - A delegation consisting of Fr. Gibbons, the Architect, and a member of the Elevator Committee met with the Commission for Buildings and Property. The meeting was one of many requirements outlined in the "Diocesan Approval Procedures for Construction or Major Renovation of All Parish Buildings". The purpose of the meeting was to present our architectural and financial plans for approval. That meeting resulted in a letter from Bishop Paprocki dated 11/23/2022, approving the preliminary plans and granting permission to proceed with final plans and specifications. Because we will be following the Diocesan Design-Bid-Build option, we are also authorized to seek bids from contractors, and to select our preferred contractor.

11/30/2022 - A joint meeting of the Elevator Committee, the Finance Council and the Architect was held. As a result of that meeting, the parish leadership decided to **move forward with the Elevator Project**.

The first order of business will be to identify and interview potential bidders. We hope to have at least three contractors competitively bid the project. After we select a contractor, St. Cecilia will need to request Bishop Paprocki's permission to proceed with construction of the project.

During our discussions with the Diocese, we were encouraged to apply for a short-term loan to ensure adequate project funding. We received loan approval for up to \$200,000. The loan is at 4% for a maximum term of 5 years. It is basically a construction loan. If we don't need or use it, there is no cost to the parish.

 Our school and residential programs serve more than 100 children per year, and we are dedicated to continue improvements and expansion of our services and programs to meet the ever-changing needs of the childrens in our communities. Construction and renovation of our building is part of our commitment to ensure that quality education and programs will continue at the Catholic Children's Home.

Every year we depend on the Christmas Day collection as the most important part of our fundraising. What better day to remember the children who, through no fault of their own, are less fortunate than our own. 


