

## Session 4 - The Sacrament of the Eucharist

_____	<b>Miracle</b>	<b>A</b>	The small wafer or piece of unleavened bread that becomes the Body of Christ.
_____	<b>Heaven</b>	<b>B</b>	Another name for the Sacrament of the Eucharist because it unites us with Jesus.
_____	<b>Bread of Life Discourse</b>	<b>C</b>	An ornate, boxlike container where the Eucharist is reserved for prayer & adoration outside of Mass.
_____	<b>Host</b>	<b>D</b>	A sign or wonder that can only be worked by God.
_____	<b>Tabernacle</b>	<b>E</b>	The Passover meal that Jesus shared with his Apostles on the night before his Crucifixion.
_____	<b>Genuflect</b>	<b>F</b>	The sacrament instituted by Christ at the Last Supper, in which bread & wine are changed into his Body & Blood.
_____	<b>Venial Sins</b>	<b>G</b>	A prayer in which we tell Jesus how much we want to be united with him.
_____	<b>Act of Spiritual Communion</b>	<b>H</b>	Another name for the Eucharist, because it is the center of the sacramental life of the Church.
_____	<b>Eucharist</b>	<b>I</b>	To bend the right knee to the floor or ground to show love & respect to Christ in the Tabernacle.
_____	<b>Lord's Supper</b>	<b>J</b>	In the Liturgy of the Mass, the sacrifice of Jesus on the Cross is made present to us.
_____	<b>Holy Sacrifice</b>	<b>K</b>	Jesus' teaching on the Eucharist in the Gospel of John, chapter 6.
_____	<b>The Most Blessed Sacrament</b>	<b>L</b>	Lesser sins that do not result in a complete separation from God.
_____	<b>Holy Communion</b>	<b>M</b>	The place where God dwells along with the angels & saints.
