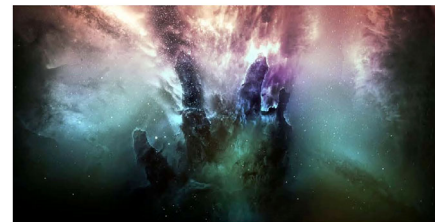

*Through the use of striking visual imagery, ethereal music and other sensory surprises, local dramatists Leigh Steiner & Don Schneider will read excerpts from Pierre Teilhard de Chardin's mystical text, Mass on the World.*



Published six years after his death, this first chapter taken from his 1961 book, *Hymn of the Universe* reveals how Teilhard, "...used the Roman Catholic Mass as a metaphor for his philosophical understanding of man in relation to the universe. The author explores in poetic prose the unity and sacredness of all creation using concepts like power, Word (logos), and fire to relate to faith terms like communion and prayer, and emphasizing the simplicity, coherence and harmony of everything through the universal presence of the Word."

## Discover Totus Tuus Week of July 14 – 19!

If you've never experienced Totus Tuus before, come discover for yourself; and if you've experienced it before, come back as we dive into a new theme for this summer—the Sacraments and the Sorrowful Mysteries. This week-long parish mission program is for youth entering 1st – 12th grades, but the entire parish can come to know more about this catechetical program through attending the parish potluck and/or by serving the young adult Totus Tuus team who spend the week here serving our youth.

**For the youth**, save the date and look for registration materials to come out later in June. The 7th – 12th grade program will be held from 7pm – 9pm every evening beginning Sunday, July 14 through Thursday, July 18. The 1st – 6th grade program will be held from 9 am – 2:30 pm every day beginning Monday, July 15 through Friday, July 19.

**For the entire parish**, mark your calendars for the parish potluck on Wednesday, July 17, where you can meet the Totus Tuus young adult team members, and learn more about Totus Tuus. Also, we are in need of parishioners to provide the following for the young adult team of 4 (usually 2 men & 2 women, but may be a 1:3 ratio this year):

- **A place to sleep and breakfast** for the male and the female members of the team. The males stay at one house and the females at another. Please contact Mike Spillers at 406-2074, if you are interested in this ministry for the team.
- **Lunches for the team**. Contact LeAnne Scheibal at the Parish Office if you can provide a lunch at noon on any day Monday – Thursday. They eat their lunch in the Parish Hall with and while the children eat their lunch during the day-time program.
- **Dinner for the team**. Contact LeAnne Scheibal if you would like to host them at your home or take the team out for a meal. Dinners are needed Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday evenings. Please note that they usually need to be on the road by 6:30 to return to the parish for the evening program.

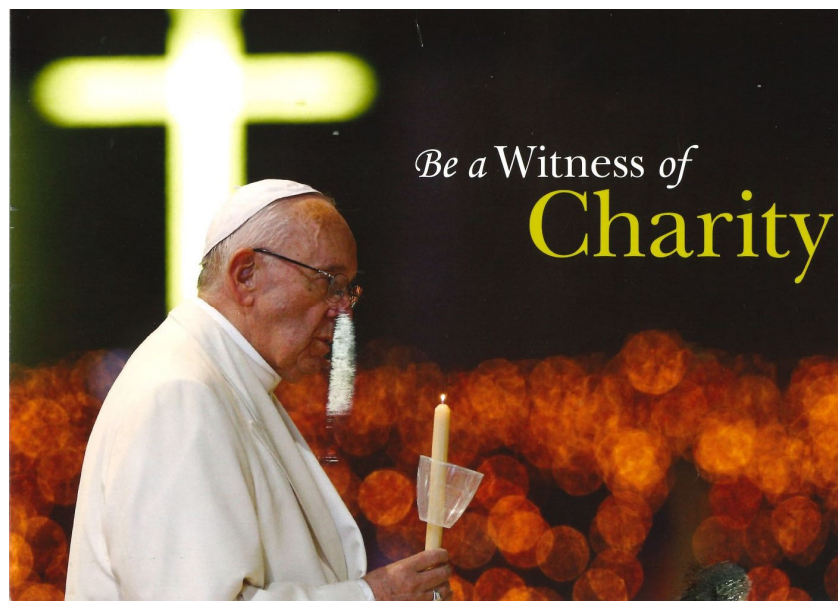
