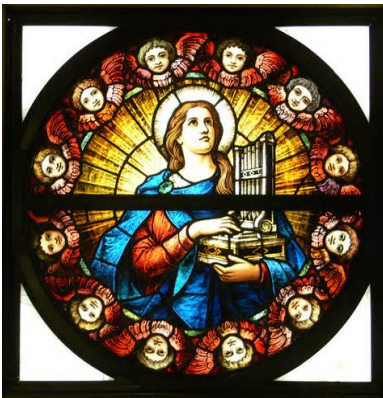

Pastor's Ramblings ...

Diocesan Council of Catholic Women

Last Saturday, June 18th, I had the privilege of con-celebrating the awards Mass for Our Lady of Good Council “Women of Distinction” along with several other priests from our diocese and Bishop Thomas John Paprocki as the chief celebrant.

Saint Cecilia Parish was honored to have Bernadette “Bernie” Guy-Marshall as its 2016 recipient. I am very proud of Bernie for accepting the award and the Diocesan Council of Catholic Women (DCCW) for recognizing her and women from other parishes within the Diocese of Springfield in Illinois. The DCCW has as its mission to “support, empower, and educate all Catholic women in spirituality, leadership and service to the needs of the church and society in the modern world”. I am sure all of you who know Bernie will agree with me that she exemplifies these qualities. Upon my arrival here at St. Cecilia, Bernie was the very first person to respond to my pleas to expand our food pantry; at a time when there was a growing movement to close it down. Bernie has worked tirelessly and with steadfast integrity to iron out the wrinkles in the operation with everything from less invasive client registration to the expansion of food product and available volunteers. We serve those who are often times between paychecks and other support resources; providing a little comfort in their lives.

As you know, I believe that as a Catholic Christian Community God calls us to feed the poor, clothe the naked, and provide shelter for the needy. He asks this in response to his promise of eternal life in his kingdom.

At the time of this writing my staff and volunteers of our parish family are preparing materials and seeking a few leaders in an effort to begin a more assertive program of outreach to the less fortunate souls in our part of God’s vineyard. It is my prayerful hope to receive an enthusiastic response to this program of public outreach in the coming weeks and months. If any of you are interested in answering the call of Pope Francis in this “Year of Mercy” please let me or my staff know of your willingness to reach out.

I will also begin seeking women who would like to begin a St. Cecilia chapter of the Catholic Council of Catholic Women to join in the Alton Deanery Council with the goal of expanding their work in our society and our local parishes.
