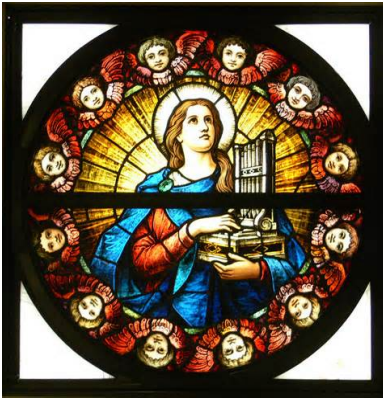

Pastor's Ramblings ...

What a beautiful 90th birthday gift to your parish; and just in time! After what seems like forever we have broken ground on the expansion and upgrade to our memorial garden. This project was first discussed shortly after my arrival at Saint Cecilia in July of 2014. The present fountain had already outlived its expected life and was deteriorated to the point that it was barely useable and by the end of fiscal year 2015 was no longer stable enough to hold water. The area surrounding the fountain and floral garden was hardly accessible to anyone with difficulty walking on the turf; this condition made the meditation benches rarely used.

My thoughts turned toward a new garden with expanded memorials and walkways from either of the side parking lots and directly from the portico of the church. It was a thought that caught on quite well and the popularity of the idea grew. We brought together a small task force to produce the beginning of what became an exciting evolution of designs and proposals to various committees. And finally several design proposals (incorporating Ed Peck's cross layout) were displayed for parishioners to peruse and comment on prior to the final decision.

The winning design is a cruciform shape with a new three-pillar design fountain. The fountain itself is designed to recycle water from beneath. There will not be a "pool" so we eliminate a good deal of evaporation and eliminate the fear of a child drowning. The "spray" of the columns of water is adjustable for aesthetical purpose. The fountain will be placed in the center of the cross with benches surrounded by floral and bush arrangements. The memorial pavers will be around the fountain area and along the three walkways. The yard area around the garden will be enhanced with two new trees.

The whole project has been made possible by a number of very generous parishioners and the selling of the memorial pavers. I am pleased to say no church funds were used in the financing of the project. I make this point to reinforce my pledge to you that I desire to restore the solid financial status of St. Cecilia parish and build back your savings to a level whereby we can eventually afford, without a fund drive, a new roof and several other major impending building repairs.

I am so excited to see this project actually begin and am so grateful to all the people who worked on it, particularly to the contributors and those memorializing their loved ones and other memories of importance to them. Finally, a big hat's off to Ed Peck, who has been an excellent project manager for this project even in his retirement!

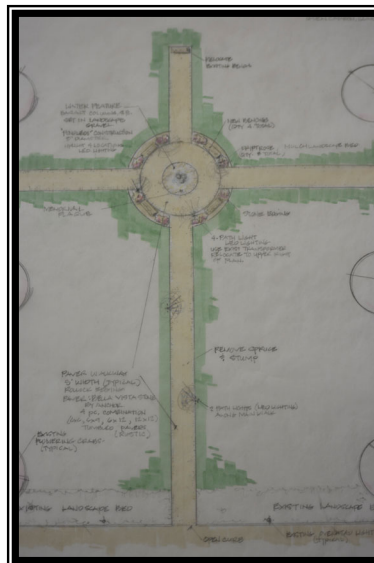
